## A BILL

To allow a permanent memorial to the victims of the September 11, 2001, terrorist attacks against the United States to be constructed on Sandy Hook in the Gateway National Recreation Area.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. MEMORIAL ON SANDY HOOK TO VICTIMS OF**  
4       **TERRORIST ATTACKS.**

5       (a) MEMORIAL.—The Secretary of the Interior,  
6 through the National Park Service, shall allow a perma-  
7 nent memorial to the victims of the September 11, 2001,  
8 terrorist attacks against the United States to be con-

1   structed on the northern end of Sandy Hook in the Gate-  
2   way National Recreation Area.

3       (b) **COMMEMORATIVE WORKS ACT.**—Section 3(c) of  
4   the Commemorative Works Act (40 U.S.C. 1003(c)) shall  
5   not apply to the memorial described in subsection (a).
