To amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to require payment of at least the minimum wage to certain drivers for all hours worked as a condition of exempting such drivers from overtime requirements.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Hour’s Pay for an
5 Hour’s Work Act of 2002”.

6 **SEC. 2. PAYMENT FOR EVERY HOUR WORKED.**

7 Section 13(b)(1) of the Fair Labor Standards Act of
8 1938 (29 U.S.C. 213(b)(1)) is amended by striking “sec-

1 tion 204 of the Motor Carrier Act, 1935” and inserting
2 the following: “section 31502 of title 49, United States
3 Code, if such employee is paid at a rate not less than the
4 minimum wage under section 6 (or is paid an amount
5 equivalent to such rate) for all hours worked”.
