Mr. SMITH of Texas introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Appropriations

A BILL

To make emergency supplemental appropriations for fiscal year 2002 to provide relief from damages caused by flooding in the Guadalupe River valley in 2002.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EMERGENCY SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIA-**
4 **TIONS.**

5 The following sums are appropriated, out of any
6 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to pro-
7 vide emergency supplemental appropriations for fiscal year
8 2002:

1 ENERGY AND WATER DEVELOPMENT
2 DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE—CIVIL
3 DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY
4 CORPS OF ENGINEERS—CIVIL
5 OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE, GENERAL

6 For an additional amount for “Operation and Main-
7 tenance, General” for repair of damages to the Canyon
8 Lake project in Texas caused by flooding in the Guadalupe
9 River valley in 2002 \$12,300,000, to remain available
10 until expended: *Provided*, That such amount is designated
11 by the Congress as an emergency requirement pursuant
12 to section 251(b)(2)(A) of the Balanced Budget and
13 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985: *Provided further*,
14 That such amount shall be available only to the extent
15 that an official budget request, that includes designation
16 of the entire amount of the request as an emergency re-
17 quirement as defined in the Balanced Budget and Emer-
18 gency Deficit Control Act of 1985, is transmitted by the
19 President to the Congress.
