## A BILL

To authorize the Court Services and Offender Supervision Agency of the District of Columbia to provide for the interstate supervision of offenders on parole, probation, and supervised release.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Court Services and  
5       Offender Supervision Agency Interstate Supervision Act  
6       of 2002”.

1 **SEC. 2. INTERSTATE SUPERVISION.**

2 Section 11233(b)(2) of the National Capital Revital-  
3 ization and Self-Government Improvement Act of 1997  
4 (sec. 24–133(b)(2), D.C. Official Code) is amended—

5 (1) by amending subparagraph (G) to read as  
6 follows:

7 “(G) arrange for the supervision of Dis-  
8 trict of Columbia offenders on parole, proba-  
9 tion, and supervised release who seek to reside  
10 in jurisdictions outside the District of Colum-  
11 bia;”;

12 (2) by striking the period at the end of sub-  
13 paragraph (H) and inserting a semicolon; and

14 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-  
15 paragraphs:

16 “(I) arrange for the supervision of offend-  
17 ers on parole, probation, and supervised release  
18 from jurisdictions outside the District of Co-  
19 lumbia who seek to reside in the District of Co-  
20 lumbia; and

21 “(J) have the authority to enter into  
22 agreements, including the Interstate Compact  
23 for Adult Offender Supervision, with any State  
24 or group of States in accordance with the Agen-

1           cy's responsibilities under subparagraphs (G)  
2           and (I).”
