A BILL

To amend the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to eliminate the funding limitation applicable to grants for special alternative instructional programs under subpart 1 of part A of title VII of such Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “English Language Ac-
5 quisition Funding Fairness Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL.**

7 Section 7116(i) of the Elementary and Secondary
8 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7426(i)) is amended—

1 (1) by amending paragraph (2) to read as fol-
2 lows:

3 “(2) EQUAL TREATMENT FOR SPECIAL ALTER-
4 NATIVE INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS.—In awarding
5 grants and distributing funds under this subpart,
6 the Secretary shall not deny an application sub-
7 mitted by, or reduce funds awarded to, any eligible
8 entity because the entity seeks to implement a spe-
9 cial alternative instructional program.”;

10 (2) by striking paragraph (3); and

11 (3) by redesignating paragraphs (4) and (5) as
12 paragraphs (3) and (4), respectively.
