3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Need-Based Edu-
5 cational Aid Act of 2001".

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS.**

7 Section 568(d) of the Improving America's Schools
8 Act of 1994 (15 U.S.C. 1 note) is repealed.
