RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 8) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to phase out the estate and gift taxes over a 10-year period, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 8) to amend
4 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to phase out the estate
5 and gift taxes over a 10-year period, and for other pur-
6 poses. The bill shall be considered as read for amendment.

1 The amendment recommended by the Committee on Ways
2 and Means now printed in the bill shall be considered as
3 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-
4 dered on the bill, as amended, and on any further amend-
5 ment thereto to final passage without intervening motion
6 except: (1) one hour of debate on the bill, as amended,
7 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-
8 ing minority member of the Committee on Ways and
9 Means; (2) the further amendment printed in the report
10 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution,
11 if offered by Representative Rangel of New York or his
12 designee, which shall be in order without intervention of
13 any point of order, shall be considered as read, and shall
14 be separately debatable for one hour equally divided and
15 controlled by the proponent and an opponent; and (3) one
16 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
