RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 41) proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States with respect to tax limitations.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the joint reso-
3 lution (H.J. Res. 41) proposing an amendment to the Con-
4 stitution of the United States with respect to tax limita-
5 tions. The joint resolution shall be considered as read for
6 amendment. The previous question shall be considered as
7 ordered on the joint resolution and any amendment there-

1 to to final passage without intervening motion except: (1)
2 two hours of debate equally divided and controlled by the
3 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee
4 on the Judiciary; (2) an amendment in the nature of a
5 substitute printed in the Congressional Record pursuant
6 to clause 8 of rule XVIII, if offered by the Minority Lead-
7 er or his designee, which shall be considered as read and
8 shall be separately debatable for one hour equally divided
9 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent; and (3)
10 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
