1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 503) to amend title 18, United States Code, and the Uni-
4 form Code of Military Justice to protect unborn children
5 from assault and murder, and for other purposes. The bill
6 shall be considered as read for amendment. The amend-

1 ment printed in the report of the Committee on Rules ac-
2 companying this resolution shall be considered as adopted.
3 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
4 the bill, as amended, and on any further amendment
5 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except:
6 (1) two hours of debate on the bill, as amended, equally
7 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
8 nority member of the Committee on the Judiciary; (2) the
9 further amendment printed in the Congressional Record
10 pursuant to clause 8 of rule XVIII and numbered 1, if
11 offered by Representative Lofgren of California or her des-
12 ignee, which shall be considered as read and shall be sepa-
13 rately debatable for one hour equally divided and con-
14 trolled by the proponent and an opponent; and (3) one
15 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
