## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1088) to amend the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 to reduce fees collected by the Securities and Exchange Commission, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of  
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 1088) to  
4 amend the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 to reduce fees  
5 collected by the Securities and Exchange Commission, and  
6 for other purposes. The bill shall be considered as read

1 for amendment. In lieu of the amendment recommended  
2 by the Committee on Financial Services now printed in  
3 the bill, the amendment in the nature of a substitute print-  
4 ed in the Congressional Record and numbered 1 pursuant  
5 to clause 8 of rule XVIII shall be considered as adopted.  
6 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on  
7 the bill, as amended, and on any further amendment  
8 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except:  
9 (1) one hour of debate on the bill, as amended, equally  
10 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-  
11 nority member of the Committee on Financial Services;  
12 (2) the further amendment printed in the Congressional  
13 Record and numbered 2 pursuant to clause 8 of rule  
14 XVIII, if offered by Representative LaFalce of New York  
15 or his designee, which shall be in order without interven-  
16 tion of any point of order, shall be considered as read,  
17 and shall be separately debatable for one hour equally di-  
18 vided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent;  
19 and (3) one motion to recommit with or without instruc-  
20 tions.
