Mrs. MYRICK, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3338) making appropriations for the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2002, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3338) making appropriations for
6 the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending Sep-

1 tember 30, 2002, and for other purposes. The first reading
2 of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order
3 against consideration of the bill are waived. General de-
4 bate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one
5 hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman and
6 ranking minority member of the Committee on Appropria-
7 tions. After general debate the bill shall be considered for
8 amendment under the five-minute rule. The amendment
9 printed in the report of the Committee on Rules accom-
10 panying this resolution shall be considered as adopted in
11 the House and in the Committee of the Whole. Points of
12 order against provisions in the bill, as amended, for failure
13 to comply with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived except
14 as follows: “to be derived from the Airport and Airway
15 Trust Fund and” on page 183, lines 24 and 25; “to be
16 derived from the Airport and Airway Trust Fund and”
17 on page 184, lines 7 and 8; “to be derived from the High-
18 way Trust Fund and” on page 184, lines 18 and 19.
19 Where points of order are waived against part of a para-
20 graph, points of order against a provision in another part
21 of such paragraph may be made only against such provi-
22 sion and not against the entire paragraph. During consid-
23 eration of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the
24 Committee of the Whole may accord priority in recognition
25 on the basis of whether the Member offering an amend-

1 ment has caused it to be printed in the portion of the Con-
2 gressional Record designated for that purpose in clause
3 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be consid-
4 ered as read. During consideration of the bill, points of
5 order against amendments for failure to comply with
6 clause 2(e) of rule XXI are waived. At the conclusion of
7 consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
8 shall rise and report the bill, as amended, to the House
9 with such amendments as may have been adopted. The
10 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the
11 bill and amendments thereto to final passage without in-
12 tervening motion except one motion to recommit with or
13 without instructions.
