## RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of motions to suspend the  
rules.

1       *Resolved*, That it shall be in order at any time on  
2 the legislative day of Thursday, December 6, 2001, for  
3 the Speaker to entertain motions that the House suspend  
4 the rules relating to the following measures:

5           (1) The bill (H.R. 3008) to reauthorize the  
6 trade adjustment assistance program under the  
7 Trade Act of 1974.

1           (2) The bill (H.R. 3129) to authorize appro-  
2           priations for fiscal years 2002 and 2003 for the  
3           United States Customs Service for antiterrorism,  
4           drug interdiction, and other operations, for the Of-  
5           fice of the United States Trade Representative, for  
6           the United States International Trade Commission,  
7           and for other purposes.
