RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of motions to suspend the rules.

1 *Resolved*, That it shall be in order at any time on
2 the legislative day of Wednesday, February 6, 2002, for
3 the Speaker to entertain motions that the House suspend
4 the rules relating to the following measures:

5 (1) The concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res.
6 312) expressing the sense of the House of Rep-
7 resentatives that the scheduled tax relief provided
8 for by the Economic Growth and Tax Relief Rec-

1 conciliation Act of 2001 passed by a bipartisan ma-
2 jority in Congress should not be suspended or re-
3 pealed.

4 (2) The joint resolution (H.J. Res. 82) recog-
5 nizing the 91st birthday of Ronald Reagan.

6 (3) The resolution (H. Res. 340) recognizing
7 and honoring Jack Shea, Olympic gold medalist in
8 speed skating, for his many contributions to the Na-
9 tion and to his community throughout his life.
