Mr. REYNOLDS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

---

# RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4664) to authorize appropriations for fiscal years 2003, 2004, and 2005 for the National Science Foundation, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4664) to authorize appropriations  
6 for fiscal years 2003, 2004, and 2005 for the National

1 Science Foundation, and for other purposes. The first  
2 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of  
3 order against consideration of the bill are waived. General  
4 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed  
5 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman  
6 and ranking minority member of the Committee on  
7 Science. After general debate the bill shall be considered  
8 for amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in  
9 order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of  
10 amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment in  
11 the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee  
12 on Science now printed in the bill. Each section of the  
13 committee amendment in the nature of a substitute shall  
14 be considered as read. During consideration of the bill for  
15 amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole  
16 may accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether  
17 the Member offering an amendment has caused it to be  
18 printed in the portion of the Congressional Record des-  
19 ignated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amend-  
20 ments so printed shall be considered as read. At the con-  
21 clusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the  
22 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with  
23 such amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member  
24 may demand a separate vote in the House on any amend-  
25 ment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill

1 or to the committee amendment in the nature of a sub-  
2 stitute. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
3 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage  
4 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit  
5 with or without instructions.
