resolution; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

RESOLUTION

Providing amounts for the expenses of the Committee on
Resources in the One Hundred Seventh Congress.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. AMOUNTS FOR COMMITTEE EXPENSES.**

3 For the expenses of the Committee on Resources, in-
4 cluding the expenses of all staff salaries, there shall be
5 paid, out of the applicable accounts of the House of Rep-
6 resentatives for committee salaries and expenses, not more
7 than \$11,980,260.00 for the One Hundred Seventh Con-
8 gress.

9 **SEC. 2. SESSION LIMITATIONS.**

10 Of the amounts specified in section 1—

1 (1) not more than \$5,804,266.00 shall be avail-
2 able for expenses incurred during the period begin-
3 ning at noon on January 3, 2001, and ending imme-
4 diately before noon on January 3, 2002; and

5 (2) not more than \$6,175,994.00 shall be avail-
6 able for expenses incurred during the period begin-
7 ning at noon on January 3, 2002, and ending imme-
8 diately before noon on January 3, 2003.

9 **SEC. 3. VOUCHERS.**

10 Payments under this resolution shall be made on
11 vouchers authorized by the Committee, signed by the
12 Chairman of the Committee, and approved in the manner
13 directed by the Committee on House Administration.

14 **SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.**

15 Amounts made available under this resolution shall
16 be expended in accordance with regulations prescribed by
17 the Committee on House Administration.

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
