## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the resolution (H. Res. 524) expressing the sense of the House that Congress should complete action on the Permanent Death Tax repeal Act of 2002, and for consideration of the resolution (H. Res. 525) expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that the 107th Congress should complete action on and present to the President, before September 30, 2002, legislation extending and strengthening the successful 1996 welfare reforms.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the resolution  
3 (H. Res. 524) expressing the sense of the House that Con-  
4 gress should complete action on the Permanent Death Tax  
5 Repeal Act of 2002, and for consideration of the resolu-  
6 tion. The resolution shall be considered as read for amend-  
7 ment. The resolution shall be debatable for one hour  
8 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-  
9 ing minority member of the Committee on Ways and  
10 Means. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
11 dered on the resolution to final adoption without inter-  
12 vening motion.

13       SEC. 2. Upon the adoption of this resolution it shall  
14 be in order to consider in the House the resolution (H.  
15 Res. 525) expressing the sense of the House of Represent-  
16 atives that the 107th Congress should complete action on  
17 and present to the President, before September 30, 2002,  
18 legislation extending and strengthening the successful  
19 1996 welfare reforms. The resolution shall be considered  
20 as read for amendment. The resolution shall be debatable  
21 for one hour equally divided among and controlled by the  
22 chairmen and ranking minority members of the Commit-  
23 tees on Ways and Means and Education and the Work-  
24 force. The previous question shall be considered as ordered

1 on the resolution to final adoption without intervening mo-  
2 tion.
