A BILL

To require the Secretary of Transportation to issue regulations to address safety concerns and to minimize delays for motorists at railroad grade crossings.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Railroad Crossing
5 Delay Reduction Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REGULATIONS.**

7 Not later than one year after the date of enactment
8 of this Act, the Secretary of Transportation shall issue
9 regulations regarding trains that block traffic at railroad

- 1 grade crossings to address safety concerns and to mini-
- 2 mize delays encountered by motorists that are caused by
- 3 such trains.
