To terminate production under the D5 submarine-launched ballistic missile program and to prohibit the backfit of certain Trident I ballistic missile submarines to carry D5 submarine-launched ballistic missiles.

Mr. FEINGOLD (for himself, Mr. HARKIN, Mr. WELLSTONE, and Mr. WYDEN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

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## A BILL

To terminate production under the D5 submarine-launched ballistic missile program and to prohibit the backfit of certain Trident I ballistic missile submarines to carry D5 submarine-launched ballistic missiles.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF D5 SUBMARINE-LAUNCHED**  
4 **BALLISTIC MISSILE PROGRAM.**

5 (a) TERMINATION OF PROGRAM.—The Secretary of  
6 Defense shall terminate production of D5 submarine-  
7 launched ballistic missiles under the D5 submarine-  
8 launched ballistic missile program.

1 (b) PAYMENT OF TERMINATION COSTS.—Funds  
2 available on or after the date of the enactment of this Act  
3 for obligation for the D5 submarine-launched ballistic mis-  
4 sile program may be obligated for production under that  
5 program only for payment of the costs associated with the  
6 termination of production under this Act.

7 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON D5 TRIDENT II BACKFIT SCHED-**  
8 **ULED TO COMMENCE IN 2005 AND 2006.**

9 (a) PROHIBITION ON BACKFIT OF CERTAIN SUB-  
10 MARINES.—The Secretary of Defense may not carry out  
11 the modifications of two Trident I submarines to enable  
12 such submarines to be deployed with Trident II D5 sub-  
13 marine-launched ballistic missiles that are currently  
14 scheduled to commence in 2005 and 2006, respectively.

15 (b) PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS.—Notwith-  
16 standing any other provision of law, no funds appropriated  
17 or otherwise made available to the Department of Defense  
18 may be obligated or expended for purposes of carrying out  
19 the modifications of Trident I submarines described in  
20 subsection (a).

21 **SEC. 3. CURRENT PROGRAM ACTIVITIES.**

22 Nothing in sections 1 and 2 shall be construed to pro-  
23 hibit or otherwise affect the availability of funds for the  
24 following:

1           (1) Production of D5 submarine-launched bal-  
2           listic missiles in production on the date of the enact-  
3           ment of this Act.

4           (2) Maintenance after the date of the enact-  
5           ment of this Act of the arsenal of D5 submarine-  
6           launched ballistic missiles in existence on such date,  
7           including the missiles described in paragraph (1).

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
