## A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Bruce Vento Hmong  
5 Veterans' Naturalization Extension Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF DEADLINES.**

7 Section 6 of the Hmong Veterans' Naturalization Act  
8 of 2000 (Public Law 106–207; 8 U.S.C. 1423 note) (as  
9 amended by Public Law 106–415) is amended by striking
