## A BILL

To extend the moratorium on the imposition of taxes on the Internet for an additional 5 years.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Defense of Internet  
5 Tax Freedom Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF MORATORIUM ON IMPOSITION OF**  
2 **TAXES ON THE INTERNET.**

3 Section 1101(a) of the Omnibus Consolidated and  
4 Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act, 1999 is  
5 amended by striking “3 years” and inserting “8 years”.
