5 **STATES COURTHOUSE.**

6 The building located at 1 Federal Plaza in New York,  
7 New York, shall be known and designated as the “~~James~~  
8 ~~L. Watson United States Court of International Trade~~  
9 ~~Building~~”. “*James L. Watson United States Courthouse*”.

10 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

11 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
12 paper, or other record of the United States to the building  
13 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference  
14 to the ~~James L. Watson United States Court of Inter-~~  
15 ~~national Trade Building~~; *to the James L. Watson United*  
16 *States Courthouse.*
