A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on railway passenger coaches of stainless steel.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RAILWAY PASSENGER COACHES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new subheading:

“	9902.86.10	Railway passenger coaches of stainless steel: one cab control and one trailer coach (pursuant to contract), gallery type coaches manufactured to contract specifications each having an aggregate seating capacity of 130–150 seats (including flip-up seats and wheelchair spaces) on two levels (provided for in subheading 8605.00.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/04	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
 3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
 4 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
