## A BILL

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Wyoming.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FEDERAL ENERGY**

4                   **REGULATORY COMMISSION HYDROELECTRIC**

5                   **PROJECT.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the time period  
7 specified in section 13 of Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.  
8 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal Energy  
9 Regulatory Commission Swift Creek Power Company, Inc.  
10 hydroelectric license, project number 1651, the Commis-

1 sion may, at the request of the licensee for the project,  
2 and after reasonable notice, in accordance with the re-  
3 quirements of that section and the Commission's proce-  
4 dures under that section, extend the time period during  
5 which the licensee is required to commence the construc-  
6 tion of the project for 3 consecutive 2-year periods.

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Subsection (a) takes effect  
8 on the date of the expiration of the extension issued by  
9 the Commission before the date of the enactment of this  
10 Act under section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.  
11 806).
