A BILL

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Wyoming.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FEDERAL ENERGY**
2 **REGULATORY COMMISSION HYDROELECTRIC**
3 **PROJECT.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Notwithstanding the time period
5 specified in section 13 of Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.
6 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal Energy
7 Regulatory Commission Swift Creek Power Company, Inc.
8 hydroelectric license, project number 1651, the Commis-
9 sion may, at the request of the licensee for the project,
10 and after reasonable notice, in accordance with the re-
11 quirements of that section and the Commission’s proce-
12 dures under that section, extend the time period during
13 which the licensee is required to commence the construc-
14 tion of the project for 3 consecutive 2-year periods.

15 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—Subsection (a) takes effect
16 on the date of the expiration of the extension issued by
17 the Commission before the date of the enactment of this
18 Act under section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.
19 806).
