3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF**

5 Subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tar-
6 iff Schedule of the United States is amended by striking
7 the date in the effective date column of subheading
8 9902.80.05 and inserting “12/31/2005”.

9 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

10 The amendment made by section 1 applies with re-
11 spect to goods entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for

- 1 consumption, on or after the date that is 15 days after
- 2 the date of the enactment of this Act.
