A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on artichokes that are prepared or preserved without vinegar or acetic acid.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON ARTICHOKES THAT**
4 **ARE PREPARED OR PRESERVED WITHOUT**
5 **VINEGAR OR ACETIC ACID.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
9 new heading:

“	9902.20.02	Artichokes, prepared or preserved without vinegar or acetic acid, and not frozen (provided for in subheading 2005.90.80)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2004	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
4 after the date of enactment of this Act.
