## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on mobile and base radio scanners that are not combined with a clock.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON MOBILE AND BASE**  
4 **RADIO SCANNERS THAT ARE NOT COMBINED**  
5 **WITH A CLOCK.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
9 new heading:

“ 9902.85.24	Electrical devices designed to receive and monitor publicly transmitted radio communications, valued at over \$40 each, that are not combined with a clock, and that are either mounted on a base or designed for use in an automobile or boat (provided for in subheading 8527.39.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2005	”.

1           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn  
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day  
4 after the date of enactment of this Act.
