## A BILL

To make a technical correction with respect to the duty suspension relating to certain polyamides.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON CERTAIN**  
4 **POLYAMIDES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subheading 9902.39.08 of the  
6 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
7 amended—

8 (1) by striking “forms of polyamide-6, poly-  
9 amide-12, and polyamide-6,12 powders (CAS No.  
10 25038–54–4, 25038–74–8, and 25191–04–1) (pro-

1 vided for in subheading 3908.10.00)” and inserting  
2 “ORGASOL® polyamide powders (provided for in  
3 subheading 3908.10.00 or 3908.90.70)”;

4 (2) by striking “12/31/2003” and inserting  
5 “12/31/2005”.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
7 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn  
8 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day  
9 after the date of enactment of this Act.
