Mr. DOMENICI introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Environment and Public Works

A BILL

To terminate the effectiveness of certain drinking water regulations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DRINKING WATER REGULATIONS.**

4 On and after the date of enactment of this Act—

5 (1) the amendments to parts 9, 141, and 142
6 of title 40, Code of Federal Regulations, made by
7 the final rule promulgated by the Administrator of
8 the Environmental Protection Agency entitled “Ar-
9 senic and Clarifications to Compliance and New
10 Source Contaminants Monitoring” (66 Fed. Reg.
11 6976 (January 22, 2001)) are void; and

1 (2) those parts shall be in effect as if those
2 amendments had not been made.
