A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain textile machinery.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TEXTILE PRINTING MACHINES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by striking heading 9902.84.20 and inserting in
7 numerical sequence the following new heading:

“ 9902.84.20	Textile printing machinery (provided for in subheading 8443.59.10)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2005	”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) shall apply to goods entered, or withdrawn

- 1 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the date that
- 2 is 15 days after the date of enactment of this Act.
