## A BILL

To authorize the conveyance of a segment of the Loring  
Petroleum Pipeline, Maine, and related easements.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE OF SEGMENT OF LORING PETRO-**  
4                       **LEUM PIPEPLINE, MAINE, AND RELATED**  
5                       **EASEMENTS.**

6       (a) CONVEYANCE AUTHORIZED.—The Secretary of  
7 the Air Force may convey, without consideration, to the  
8 Loring Development Authority, Maine (in this section re-  
9 ferred to as the “Authority”), all right, title, and interest  
10 of the United States in and to the segment of the Loring

1 Petroleum (POL) Pipeline, Maine, that was not previously  
2 conveyed to the Authority following the closure of Loring  
3 Air Force Base, Maine. The segment is approximately 27  
4 miles in length and runs between the Searsport terminal  
5 and Bangor Air National Guard Base.

6 (b) RELATED EASEMENTS.—As part of the convey-  
7 ance authorized by subsection (a), the Secretary may con-  
8 vey to the Authority, without consideration, all right, title,  
9 and interest of the United States in and to any easements  
10 or rights-of-way necessary for the operation or mainte-  
11 nance of the segment of pipeline conveyed under that sub-  
12 section.

13 (c) DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY.—The exact acreage  
14 and legal description of the segment of pipeline to be con-  
15 veyed under subsection (a), and of any easements or  
16 rights-of-way to be conveyed under subsection (b), shall  
17 be determined by surveys and other means satisfactory to  
18 the Secretary. The cost of any survey or other services  
19 performed at the direction of the Secretary under the pre-  
20 ceding sentence shall be borne by the Authority.

21 (d) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The  
22 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-  
23 tions in connection with the conveyances under this section

1 as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the inter-  
2 ests of the United States.
