Mr. BAYH (for himself and Mr. LUGAR) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Environment and Public Works

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## A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Army to assist in the continued development of the Indianapolis Central Waterfront project in Indianapolis, Indiana.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Indianapolis Central  
5 Waterfront Act of 2002”.

6 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

7 Congress finds that—

8 (1) the Army Corps of Engineers has provided  
9 study, design, and construction assistance to the In-

1       Indianapolis Central Waterfront project along the  
2       White River in Indianapolis, Indiana;

3               (2) to date, \$110,975,000 in both Federal and  
4       non-Federal dollars has been used to implement por-  
5       tions of the Master Plan;

6               (3) the 1994 Indianapolis Central Waterfront  
7       Master Plan outlines additional features that could  
8       be constructed;

9               (4) the city of Indianapolis is committed to pro-  
10      viding any required non-Federal cost share to ensure  
11      that the elements detailed in the 1994 Master Plan  
12      are carried out;

13              (5) the Master Plan specifically cited flood con-  
14      trol, river edge improvements, and water resource  
15      improvements that could be implemented in the Fall  
16      Creek reach of the White River; and

17              (6) the Fall Creek Reach consists of the ele-  
18      ments described in the 1994 Master Plan as—

19                      (A) Fall Creek River Edge Improvements;

20                      (B) Fall Creek Park;

21                      (C) Fall Creek Lake; and

22                      (D) Aqueduct.

23 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION.**

24       The project for flood control, Indianapolis, Indiana,  
25      Fall Creek Reach, authorized by section 5 of an Act enti-

1 tled “An Act authorizing the construction of certain public  
2 works on rivers and harbors for flood control and other  
3 purposes”, approved June 22, 1936 (49 Stat. 1586, chap-  
4 ter 688), as modified by section 323 of the Water Re-  
5 sources Development Act of 1996 (110 Stat. 3716) and  
6 by section 322 of the Water Resources Development Act  
7 of 1999 (113 Stat. 303), is modified to authorize the Sec-  
8 retary to—

9           (1) assist with the Fall Creek Reach element of  
10       the Indianapolis Central Waterfront project as de-  
11       scribed in the 1994 project Master Plan at a total  
12       cost of \$28,545,000, with an estimated Federal cost  
13       of \$14,272,500 and an estimated non-Federal cost  
14       of \$14,272,500; and

15           (2) construct the project at a total cost of  
16       \$139,520,000, with an estimated Federal cost of  
17       \$66,747,000 and an estimated non-Federal cost of  
18       \$72,773,000.

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
