1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MODIFICATION OF FLOOD CONTROL PROJECT,**

4 **LITTLE CALUMET RIVER, INDIANA.**

5 The project for flood control, Little Calumet River,
6 Indiana, authorized by section 401(a) of the Water Re-
7 sources Development Act of 1986 (100 Stat. 4115), is
8 modified to authorize the Secretary of the Army to con-
9 struct the project substantially in accordance with the
10 post-authorization change report of the Corps of Engi-

1 neers dated August 2000, at a total cost of \$187,000,000,
2 with an estimated Federal cost of \$137,000,000 and an
3 estimated non-Federal cost of \$50,000,000.
