A BILL

To clarify the boundaries of the Plum Island Unit of the Coastal Barrier Resources System.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPLACEMENT OF COASTAL BARRIER RE-**
4 **SOURCES SYSTEM MAP.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—In the maps depicting the Coastal
6 Barrier Resources System that are referred to in section
7 4(a) of the Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16 U.S.C.
8 3503(a)), the map described in subsection (b) is replaced
9 by the map entitled “Plum Tree Island Unit VA–59P,

1 Long Creek Unit VA-60/VA-60P” and dated May 1,
2 2002.

3 (b) DESCRIPTION OF REPLACED MAP.—The map de-
4 scribed in this subsection is the map that—

5 (1) relates to Plum Island Unit VA-59P and
6 Long Creek Unit VA-60/VA-60P located in
7 Poquoson and Hampton, Virginia; and

8 (2) is included in a set of maps entitled
9 ‘Coastal Barrier Resources System”, dated October
10 24, 1990, revised on October 23, 1992, and referred
11 to in section 4(a) of the Coastal Barrier Resources
12 Act (16 U.S.C. 3503(a)).

13 **SEC. 2. AVAILABILITY.**

14 The Secretary of the Interior shall maintain the re-
15 placement map referred to in section 1 on file and avail-
16 able for inspection in accordance with section 4(b) of the
17 Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16 U.S.C. 3503(b)).
