3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO THE PRESIDENTIAL PROTEC-**
4 **TION ASSISTANCE ACT OF 1976.**

5 Section 12 of the Presidential Protection Assistance
6 Act of 1976 (Public Law 94-524; ____ U.S.C. ____) is

1 amended by striking the period at the end and inserting
2 “: *Provided further*, That the President may designate an
3 additional temporary non-governmental property (subject
4 to the population limitations of this section) to be secured
5 by the Secret Service for protection of the President for
6 a period of not to exceed 60 days each fiscal year and
7 the expenses of affected State and local governments may
8 be reimbursed as provided in this section in an amount
9 not to exceed \$100,000 in any 1 fiscal year.”.
