Mrs. FEINSTEIN (for herself and Mr. INHOFE) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Environment and Public Works

A BILL

To amend the Clean Air Act to permit the Governor of a State to waive the oxygen content requirement for reformulated gasoline, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF OXYGEN CONTENT REQUIREMENT**
4 **FOR REFORMULATED GASOLINE.**

5 Section 211(k)(1) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.
6 7545(k)(1)) is amended—

7 (1) by striking “Within 1 year after the enact-
8 ment of the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990,”
9 and inserting the following:

1 “(A) IN GENERAL.—Not later than No-
2 vember 15, 1991,”; and

3 (2) by adding at the end the following:

4 “(B) WAIVER OF OXYGEN CONTENT RE-
5 QUIREMENT.—

6 “(i) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding
7 any other provision of this subsection,
8 upon notification by the Governor of a
9 State to the Administrator, a Governor
10 may waive paragraphs (2)(B) and
11 (3)(A)(v) with respect to gasoline sold or
12 dispensed in the State.

13 “(ii) TREATMENT AS REFORMULATED
14 GASOLINE.—In the case of a State for
15 which the Governor invokes the waiver de-
16 scribed in clause (i), gasoline that complies
17 with all provisions of this subsection other
18 than paragraphs (2)(B) and (3)(A)(v) shall
19 be considered to be reformulated gasoline
20 for the purposes of this subsection.”.

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
