3 **SECTION 1. HORATIO KING POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 39 Tremont Street, Paris Hill,
6 Maine, shall be known as the “Horatio King Post Office
7 Building”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
2 be deemed to be a reference to the Horatio King Post Of-
3 fice Building.
