CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That, in consonance with section 132(a) of
3 the Legislative Reorganization Act of 1946, when the Sen-
4 ate recesses or adjourns at the close of business on Thurs-
5 day, August 1, 2002, Friday, August 2, 2002, or Satur-
6 day, August 3, 2002, on a motion offered pursuant to this
7 concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his des-
8 ignee, it stand recessed or adjourned until 12:00 noon on
9 Tuesday, September 3, 2002, or until such other time on
10 that day as may be specified by its Majority Leader or
11 his designee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until
12 Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to section
13 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and
14 that when the House adjourns on the legislative day of
15 Friday, July 26, 2002, on a motion offered by its Majority
16 Leader or his designee pursuant to this concurrent resolu-
17 tion, it stand adjourned until 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday,
18 September 4, 2002, or until Members are notified to reas-

1 semble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,
2 whichever occurs first.

3 SEC. 2. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the
4 Speaker of the House, or their respective designees, acting
5 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
6 Senate and the Minority Leader of the House, shall notify
7 the Members of the Senate and House, respectively, to re-
8 assemble at such place and time as they may designate
9 whenever, in their opinion, the public interest shall war-
10 rant it.
