Mr. BROWNBACK submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules and Administration

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To designate a National Day of Reconciliation.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That on a date to be determined by the
3 Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Presi-
4 dent pro tempore of the Senate, the Chaplain of the House
5 of Representatives and the Chaplain of the Senate shall
6 conduct a joint assembly, to be conducted in the House
7 Chamber, in which Members of the House of Representa-
8 tives and the Senate will be able to express the past strug-
9 gles that we as a Nation have experienced, overcome, and
10 still struggle with, and thereby lead the Nation in begin-
11 ning the process of reconciliation.
