Mr. DASCHLE submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was
considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for the sine die adjournment of the One Hundred
Seventh Congress, Second Session.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate adjourns at the close
3 of business on any day from Wednesday, November 20,
4 2002 through Saturday, November 23, 2002, or from
5 Monday, November 25, 2002 through Wednesday, Novem-
6 ber 27, 2002, or on a motion offered pursuant to this con-
7 current resolution by its Majority Leader, or his designee,
8 it stand adjourned sine die, or until Members are notified
9 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-
10 olution, whichever occurs first; and that when the House

1 of Representatives adjourns on any legislative day through
2 the remainder of the second session of the One Hundred
3 Seventh Congress on a motion offered pursuant to this
4 concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his des-
5 ignee, it stand adjourned sine die, or until Members are
6 notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concur-
7 rent resolution, whichever occurs first.

8 SEC. 2. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the
9 Speaker of the House, or their respective designees, acting
10 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
11 Senate and the Minority Leader of the House, shall notify
12 the Members of the Senate and the House, respectively,
13 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-
14 ignate whenever, in their opinion, the public interest shall
15 warrant it.
