Mr. DASCHLE submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment or recess of the Senate and a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate recesses or adjourns
3 at the close of business on Thursday, February 14, 2002,
4 or Friday, February 15, 2002, on a motion offered pursu-
5 ant to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader
6 or his designee, it stand recessed or adjourned until 12:00
7 noon on Monday, February 25, 2002, or until such other
8 time on that day as may be specified by its Majority Lead-
9 er or his designee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or
10 until Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to sec-

1 tion 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first;
2 and that when the House adjourns on the legislative day
3 of Thursday, February 14, 2002, it stand adjourned until
4 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 26, 2002, or until Mem-
5 bers are notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of
6 this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

7 SEC. 2. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the
8 Speaker of the House, acting jointly after consultation
9 with the Minority Leader of the Senate and the Minority
10 Leader of the House, shall notify the Members of the Sen-
11 ate and House, respectively, to reassemble at such place
12 and time as they may designate whenever, in their opinion,
13 the public interest shall warrant it.
