1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO SENATE RESOLUTION 294.**

3 Section 2(3) of Senate Resolution 294, Ninety-sixth
4 Congress, agreed to April 29, 1980, is amended—

5 (1) by striking “and” after “copies of the book
6 ‘We, the People,’” and inserting a comma; and

7 (2) by inserting before the semicolon at the end
8 the following: “, copies of the book ‘A Young Per-
9 son’s Guide to the United States Capitol’ published
10 by the United States Capitol Historical Society, and
11 copies of the book ‘Exploring Capitol Hill: A Kid’s

1 Guide to the U.S. Capitol and Congress’ published
2 by the United States Capitol Historical Society’.

3 **SEC. 2. COPIES DEEMED TO BE FEDERAL PUBLICATIONS.**

4 Copies of the book “A Young Person’s Guide to the
5 United States Capitol” published by the United States
6 Capitol Historical Society, and copies of the book “Explor-
7 ing Capitol Hill: A Kid’s Guide to the U.S. Capitol and
8 Congress” published by the United States Capitol Histor-
9 ical Society shall be deemed to be Federal publications de-
10 scribed in section 6(b)(1)(B)(v) of Public Law 103–283.
