Mr. DODD submitted the following resolution; which was considered and agreed to

RESOLUTION

Authorizing the Sergeant at Arms and Doorkeeper of the Senate to ascertain and settle claims arising out of anthrax exposure in the Senate complex.

1 *Resolved*, That (a) the Sergeant at Arms and Door-
2 keeper of the Senate—

3 (1) in accordance with such regulations as the
4 Committee on Rules and Administration may pre-
5 scribe, may consider and ascertain any claim inci-
6 dent to service by a Member, officer, or employee of
7 the Senate for any damage to, or loss of, personal
8 property, for which the Member, officer, or employee
9 has not been reimbursed, resulting from the anthrax
10 incident of October 15, 2001, or the related remedi-

1 ation efforts undertaken from such date through
2 March 15, 2002; and

3 (2) may, with the approval of the Committee on
4 Rules and Administration and in accordance with
5 the provisions of section 3721 of title 31, United
6 States Code, determine, compromise, adjust, and
7 settle such claim in an amount not exceeding \$4,000
8 per claimant.

9 (b) Claimants shall file claims pursuant to this reso-
10 lution with the Sergeant at Arms not later than December
11 31, 2002.

12 (c) Any compromise, adjustment, or settlement of any
13 such claim pursuant to this resolution shall be paid from
14 the contingent fund of the Senate on a voucher approved
15 by the chairman of the Committee on Rules and Adminis-
16 tration.
