Dame for winning the 2001 women's basketball cham-
pionship.

Whereas the University of Notre Dame women's basketball
team won its first national championship by defeating the
tenacious Purdue University Boilermakers by the score of
68–66;

Whereas for the first time in NCAA women's basketball his-
tory, two teams from the same State appeared in the
championship game;

Whereas Ruth Riley, named the Final Four's outstanding
player and a native of Macy, Indiana, led the University
of Notre Dame with 28 points and made 2 free throws
with 5.8 seconds left in the game to secure a victory;
