3 **SECTION 1. PRINTING OF DOCUMENT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The transcripts of the proceedings
5 of “The Changing Nature of the House Speakership: The

1 Cannon Centenary Conference”, sponsored by the Con-
2 gressional Research Service on November 12, 2003, shall
3 be printed as a House document, in a style and manner
4 determined by the Joint Committee on Printing.

5 (b) ADDITIONAL COPIES FOR HOUSE AND SEN-
6 ATE.—There shall be printed for the use of the House of
7 Representatives and the Senate such aggregate number of
8 copies of the document printed under subsection (a) as
9 the Joint Committee on Printing determines to be appro-
10 priate, except that the maximum number of copies which
11 may be printed shall be the number for which the aggre-
12 gate printing cost does not exceed \$65,000.
