CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the printing of “History of the United States
Capitol” as a House document.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF PRINTING.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—There shall be printed as a House
5 document the book entitled “History of the United States

1 Capitol” by Glenn Brown, as prepared under the auspices
2 of the Architect of the Capitol with support from the
3 United States Capitol Preservation Commission and the
4 United States Capitol Historical Society.

5 (b) SPECIFICATIONS.—The document described in
6 subsection (a) shall include illustrations and shall be in
7 the style, form, manner, and binding as directed by the
8 Joint Committee on Printing after consultation with the
9 Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Secretary
10 of the Senate.

11 **SEC. 2. NUMBER OF COPIES.**

12 In addition to the usual number, there shall be print-
13 ed for the use of the House of Representatives and Senate
14 the lesser of—

15 (1) 7,000 copies of the document described in
16 section 1(a), to be allocated as determined jointly by
17 the Clerk of the House of Representatives and the
18 Secretary of the Senate; or

19 (2) such maximum number of copies of the doc-
20 ument as does not have a total production and

1 printing cost of more than \$182,000, with distribu-
2 tion to be allocated as described in paragraph (1).
