## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Permitting the use of the rotunda of the Capitol for a ceremony as part of the commemoration of the days of remembrance of victims of the Holocaust.

1       *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That the rotunda of the Capitol is authorized  
3 to be used on April 22, 2004, for a ceremony as part of  
4 the commemoration of the days of remembrance of victims  
5 of the Holocaust. Physical preparations for the ceremony  
6 shall be carried out in accordance with such conditions as  
7 the Architect of the Capitol may prescribe.
