CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of the Capitol Grounds for activities
associated with the dedication of the National World
War II Memorial.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF USE OF CAPITOL**
4 **GROUND FOR NATIONAL WORLD WAR II ME-**
5 **MORIAL DEDICATION.**

6 The Capitol Grounds may be used for a public event
7 providing additional space in conjunction with the dedica-
8 tion of the National World War II Memorial on May 29,
9 2004, or on such other date as the Speaker of the House

1 of Representatives and the Committee on Rules and Ad-
2 ministration of the Senate may jointly designate.

3 **SEC. 2. CONDITIONS.**

4 The event to be carried out under this resolution shall
5 be free of admission charge to the public and arranged
6 not to interfere with the needs of Congress, under condi-
7 tions to be prescribed by the Architect of the Capitol and
8 the Capitol Police Board.

9 **SEC. 3. STRUCTURES AND EQUIPMENT.**

10 For the purposes of this resolution, the Architect of
11 the Capitol is authorized to erect on Capitol Grounds such
12 stage, sound amplification devices, and other related struc-
13 tures and equipment as may be required for the event to
14 be carried out under this resolution.

15 **SEC. 4. ADDITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS.**

16 The Architect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police
17 Board are authorized to make any such additional ar-
18 rangements that may be required to carry out the event
19 under this resolution.

20 **SEC. 5. ENFORCEMENT OF RESTRICTIONS.**

21 The Capitol Police Board shall provide for enforce-
22 ment of the restrictions contained in section 4 of the Act
23 of July 31, 1946 (40 U.S.C. 5104(c); 60 Stat. 718), con-
24 cerning sales, advertisements, displays, and solicitations
25 on the Capitol Grounds, as well as other restrictions appli-

- 1 cable to the Capitol Grounds, with respect to the event
- 2 to be carried out under this resolution.
