## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Directing the Clerk of the House of Representatives to make certain corrections to the enrollment of H.R. 1350.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That, in the enrollment of the bill (H.R.  
3 1350) to reauthorize the Individuals with Disabilities Edu-  
4 cation Act, and for other purposes, the Clerk of the House  
5 of Representatives shall make the following corrections:

1           (1) Modify section 674(c)(1)(D) of the Individ-  
2 uals with Disabilities Education Act, as amended by  
3 section 101 of the Individuals with Disabilities Edu-  
4 cation Improvement Act of 2004, by striking “and  
5 secondary schools” and inserting “, secondary  
6 schools, postsecondary schools, and graduate  
7 schools”.

8           (2) Modify section 612(a)(14) of the Individuals  
9 with Disabilities Education Act, as amended by sec-  
10 tion 101 of the Individuals with Disabilities Edu-  
11 cation Improvement Act of 2004, by—

12                   (A) redesignating subparagraphs (C) and  
13                   (D) as subparagraphs (D) and (E), respectively;  
14                   and

15                   (B) by inserting after subparagraph (B)  
16                   the following:

17                           “(C) QUALIFICATIONS FOR SPECIAL EDU-  
18                           CATION TEACHERS.—The qualifications de-  
19                           scribed in subparagraph (A) shall ensure that  
20                           each person employed as a special education  
21                           teacher in the State who teaches elementary  
22                           school, middle school, or secondary school is  
23                           highly qualified by the deadline established in

1 section 1119(a)(2) of the Elementary and Sec-  
2 ondary Education Act of 1965.
