## JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United  
States regarding the right to vote.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 *(two-thirds of each House concurring therein),* That the fol-  
4 lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-  
5 stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all  
6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when  
7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several  
8 States:



1 and shall ensure that each Elector votes for the candidate  
2 for President and Vice President who received a majority  
3 of the popular vote in the State or District.

4 “SECTION 5. The Congress shall have power to en-  
5 force this article by appropriate legislation.”.
